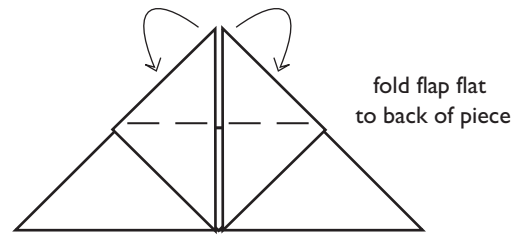
collapse into waterbomb base



fold point to opposite edge

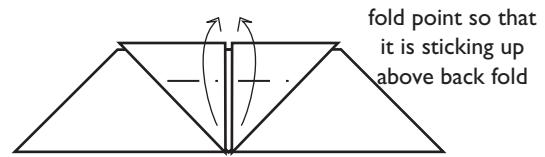


fold top flap of paper only

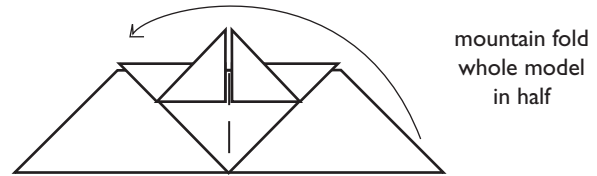


fold flap flat to back of piece

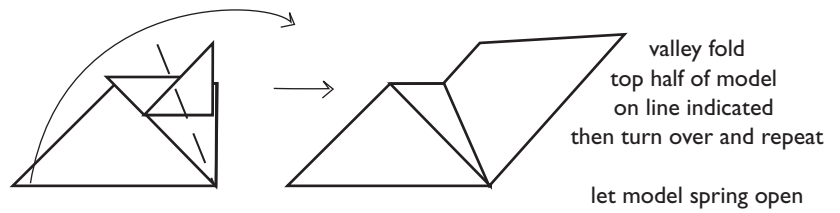
turn over



fold point so that it is sticking up above back fold

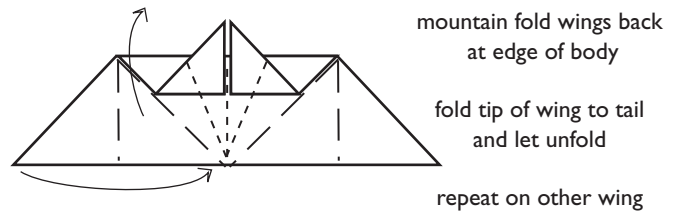


mountain fold whole model in half



valley fold top half of model on line indicated then turn over and repeat

let model spring open

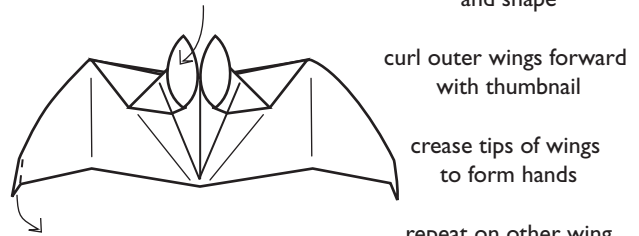


mountain fold wings back at edge of body

fold tip of wing to tail and let unfold

repeat on other wing

open ear flaps with thumb and shape



curl outer wings forward with thumbnail

crease tips of wings to form hands

repeat on other wing

if using duo-paper, the interior of the ears will be a contrasting color



a 9" square of paper yields a 6" x 3" bat
